This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English, Maths and Science across
Prep to Year 6 to 80%
- Increase the number of students exiting from Prep with a PM Reading Level of >5.
- Support each student at risk of not achieving Regional reading benchmarks with tailored support programs and particular emphasis in Prep to Year 2.
- Increase the number of students reading at benchmark or above to 75%

Our initiatives include

- Implement the Churchill State School Reading Framework and adopting consistent teaching protocols
- Employ a Pedagogy coach to assist in the implementation a whole school approach to the explicit teaching of phonics
- Intensive teacher aide support in during literacy for support in guided reading
- Continue Reading Champions program for students reading below Regional Benchmarks in Prep to Yr 2.
- Developing a case-management approach to strengthen reading instruction, supported by Leadership team.
- Increase school based Chaplain to 3 days a week to deliver social and emotional well-being programs to increase students engagement at school
- Releasing teachers to engage with the Head of Curriculum to align planning with the Australian Curriculum.
- Implementing the Superhero Reading Squad to improve the number of students reading in the U2B
